



Enrollment Agreement

By signing this agreement parents/guardians agree, acknowledge and accept:

- to support the school's mission, core values, strategic objectives and all initiatives towards their achievement.
- the payment of all fees as established by the school in accordance with authorized payment plans. These include additional fees for special programs that may be recommended and required to support an individual student, but may not be known at the time of enrollment. In the case of non payment of general and special programs the school may restrict students from attending classes, withhold report cards, and/or refuse re-enrollment for the following semester.
- to support the schools academic program and understand that meeting country or region specific curriculums outside the school's curriculum may not be possible or supported.
- to familiarize themselves with the information and follow the guidelines presented in the Student/Parent Handbooks which are available on the school's website
- to ensure the student's regular attendance at the school.
- the need for the student to be living with either a parent or a legal guardian approved by the school.
- to work in partnership with the school and support the student at home in order to help him/her meet the school's academic and behavioral expectations.
- to enrich and support the student's home language acquisition as much as possible.
- to support the school's academic programs.
- to accept and support the student's
 - grade level placement
 - class list placement
 - EAL placement
 - Learning support placement and service model
- use the proper channels of communication established by the school when seeking resolution to a problem or concern (i.e. initial contact with the teacher or person closest to the issue, then, if necessary forwarding the issue to relevant Principal and finally, if needed to the Director)
- to contribute to a positive school environment, promote tolerance and harmony, and refrain from behavior or comments that may damage the image of the school, the staff or any member of the school community.
- to acquire sufficient information and understanding about the academic programs, curriculum and co-curricular activities by attending parent evenings, parent-teacher conferences and other parent information events.

Parent/Guardian non-compliance with this enrollment agreement and the guidelines of Copenhagen International School may result in a student not being recommended admission or recommend for withdrawal from classes or school.
